





Handpicked Tours

A walk back in time

"Take a walk down the aisles of history."

This city tour will introduce you to some of the most iconic landmarks of the capital of Mauritius. Walking through the lively, bustling streets, you will learn more about the nearly three-centuries-old city of Port Louis, from a glimpse into the history of postal services to roaming at leisure through a trendy waterfront shopping complex.







Melting Pot

Get ready for a full day of historical and cultural discovery. In a nutshell, you will get an up-close look at many of the landmarks and attractions that make Mauritius stand out as a unique kaleidoscope of ethnicities, religions, traditions, and languages from varying parts of the world.

Chamarel Experience

The small bucolic village of Chamarel is situated at around 300 metres above sea level and offers a sweeping bird's eye view of the entire South-West of the island. Steeped in authenticity and simplicity, it is known for its winding road, amazing geological features, lush vegetation, cultural attractions and more





Casela World of Adventures

"An adventurer's delight."

One of the island's most popular attractions, Casela offers a unique experience for nature lovers and families. This over 350-hectare park has five different sections for everyone to enjoy, from mountain and rope activities to an African reserve, rides and ample space for events.



Bel Ombre Nature Reserve

"Connecting with the wonders of nature"

Dive into the heart of the Bel Ombre Nature Reserve to discover an incredible diversity of ecosystems and protected landscapes offering a large number of endemic and exotic plant and bird species, as well as the vestiges of almost three centuries of human occupation. A sanctuary where you can indulge in a wide variety of activities close to nature.





World of Seashells

The only seashell museum in Mauritius houses a collection of 8,000 pieces from around the world. A visit to the World of Seashells Museum will enable you to learn a lot about their morphology, living mechanism, defence system, patterns and colours. You will also find very interesting information about how shells have been used by man over the ages.

Helicopter

Zip Lines

Practical Information

Don't leave your belongings unattended at any time. Also remember to keep valuables in your hotel room safe.

Local products should not be excessively expensive, make sure to ask for advice from your guide/representative before buying.

Guests are advised to monitor their behaviour and abide by the site specific restrictions during visits.

Historical and archeological artifacts are not permitted to be sold, traded or displayed except as permitted by local and international law

Beach hawkers

Purchase products and services from licensed operators only. Ask for the price beforehand and be careful with those that are too tenacious. Also make sure your purse is out of sight and avoid carrying valuables with you. Finally, beware of counterfeit articles.

Clothing

Lightweight, tropical clothing is most advisable. Dress is usually casual except in the evening at the restaurants and bars of most hotels, when shorts and T-shirts are not allowed. Between June and October, a jacket or cardigan is recommended. Dress appropriately when visiting places of worship and remove your shoes when entering mosques and temples.

Safety

Swimming is safe if you stick to the rules. Be aware of currents and swim only in designated areas.

Currency

The national currency is the Mauritian rupee. Credit/debit cards are widely used and there are plenty of ATMs available. It is wise to have some local currency for minor purchases. Banks and foreign exchange counters are normally open weekdays from 9am to 3pm.

Language

English is the official language; French and Creole are also spoken island-wide.

Be sure to bring sunglasses, mosquito repellent and sunscreen. It can be helpful to have a rash guard to protect from the sun when snorkelling or doing any water activities. You will also need the proper footwear to go hiking.

Shops

Shops are open from 9.30am to 5pm every day and until midday on Thursdays, Sundays and public holidays. Certain shops also work longer hours in malls around the island.
